

Together on Reading

Government's strategy 2024-2030

- An international, national, communal, and local problem!
 - Do you forego books in favor of scrolling on your mobile device or watching a tv series?
 - Are you a good role model?
 - Why read? What does 15 minutes a day really do?
- Children's reading habits are closely connected with how well they read.
 - Development: Reading less, worse reading according to PISA (15 year olds competency) PIRLS (10 year olds competency)
- Norwegian children lowest reading levels (out of 65 countries in PIRLS)











Good vocabular – regardless of langauge!

- A 7 year old has 5000 words
- A 17 year old who does not read has only 15
 000 words
- A 17 year old who reads has over
- 50-70 000 words

Reading habits are changing

- Little to no reading out loud in classrooms for the youngest (evaluering seksårsreformen)
- On the rise- the number of 9 to 19 year olds who do not read books
- 1 of 3 parents report that they do not read or read few books to their children 3 to 6 years old (nasjonalt lesesenter 2023)
- 93 % of children between 9 and 11 have a cell phone!

What does research say about use of Screens

Reading on a screen

- We don't have iPads for reading. We use them to create, produce, aid and support.
- Students with learning difficulties should use screens for reading as there are more adaptations and opportunities for differentiation.

Reading on paper

- Children should read more on paper.
- Longer and more complex texts
- Active reading strategies in school with subject textsthe school's focus this fall

What is reading? Joint responsiblity

School's responsibility

- Teaching to read
- Reading development and progression
- Reading strategies
- Reading for learning
- Motivation and desire

Home responsiblity

- Read out loud
 - Adolescents: In example: Read a paragraph from your homework out loud each week
- Be a reading model
- Practice endurance and motivation
- Donate used books to the library?

ICT at Manglerud skole

- A system that is easy to access for all students overview of all subjects
 - A channel strategy: which platforms should be used for what purpose
 - Simple an predictable structure– logical file system and visual support
- Good support for students with learning difficulties- and reading difficulties
- Digital competencies digital citizenship
- Activities that are relevant for learning provide added value
 - Not for reading long subject texts
 - Relevant, practical and varied instruction
 - Increased motivation—interactive classrooms
 - Feedback and evaluating
 – better knowledge and closer follow up

Summary for parents

- Read out loud to your children
- Be a good reading role model.
- Support your children with challenging feelings, teach them it is not necessarily bad to be challenged. Let them practice feeling uneasy and meeting resistance
- iPad is a school tool— take time to know how the school uses sit. Use JAMF! Feedback to FAU if there is something you are wondering about.
- Read the weekly plan— ask about TROA and Reading
