Natteravn at Manglerud school

Manglerud school and Høyenhall school collaborate on the natteravn arrangement in the Manglerud / Høyenhall area. The schools alternate for three weeks. It is FAU that organizes the natteravn arrangement.

At Manglerud school, the natteravn shifts are divided into 5th-10th grade on Wednesdays and Fridays. Manglerud International classes are also part of this arrangement.

Why do we go natteravn?

Natteravn is about being present for children and young people when they travel outside in the evening, taking responsibility and showing compassionate care when the young people need it.

Together we can help create security, well-being and belonging in our local community so that children and young people have a safer upbringing.

As a natteravn, you get the opportunity to discuss with, and learn from other parents. You get an insight into your children's world outside the home and knowledge of what the youth are interested in. You will also get some exercise and the chance to make new contacts.

The presence and visibility of the natteravner in the area also helps to reduce violence, vandalism and criminal acts.

A new skate park, bicycle park and pool has opened, and we expect there will be more young people present in the streets.

Routines and practical information

The FAU representatives are responsible for obtaining a minimum of 2 people from their class who can walk on the set dates of the class. At the beginning of the school year, lists will be published of which classes will be responsible in the different weeks. Most classes have their own facebook page and it is common to write posts here a few weeks before the scheduled week. The natteravn group in FAU will remind the FAU representatives to provide volunteers, as well as be responsible for keys, routines and set-up of weeks. Routines and practical info to be found here:
